

INSTRUCTION FOR OPENING BOXES AND BLISTERS OF ALL ROOTT NON STERILE PRODUCTS



Make sure the package is not damaged before use. Do not use if package is damaged.

All ROOTT superstructures, instruments and drills are packed in blisters and boxes. Box consists of 1 blister with 5 separate parts, for easier management.




In each part can be:

a) 1 piece or b) 5 pieces



One part of the blister can be break out and opened separately. Blisters can be removed one by one separately:



Instruments that are longer than 41 mm are packed in a plastic box:



Prepare a round bowl, instrument tray or soaking tube:

3 Take instrument out






DRILLS
